## Local attractions

### Craters to Coast Discovery - Fresh, Fun, Adventure!

Bring your family to play in nature's greatest theme park. Hunt the roaring wind, navigate for hidden treasure, explore the night sky, track local fauna, learn to read history in rocks and use your detective skills to uncover the secrets of our southern landscapes.

The Craters to Coast Discovery Program loans telescopes, anemometers, GPS units, digital cameras and compasses to explore the region, complete themed activities and earn great prizes along the way.

Equipment loan is free of charge (participants are required to provide credit card details and fill out an equipment loan form.) All equipment, activity sheets and details are available from the Port Campbell Visitor Information Centre 1300 137 255.

### 12 Apostles Penguins

Watch the penguins come home from a very busy day fishing off the coast of Port Campbell after sunset. The comical antics of little penguins can be observed from two cliff top vantage points in Port Campbell National Park. Observe the complex social behavior of their nightly return at both the 12 Apostles and London Bridge viewing platforms.

Arrival times vary according to time of year. The best guide is to be settled onto the viewing platform by sunset, penguins generally appear between 10 and 15 minutes after sunset with their mass exit usually occurring 20 and 25 minutes later as twilight fades to dark. Much communication occurs as the penguins return from the sea including the odd territorial dispute.

The population of birds is significantly more at the 12 Apostles (around 800 birds) but viewers are a little closer to the birds at London Bridge.

You can loan a pair binoculars from Port Campbell Visitor Information Centre to get an even closer look from the 12 apostles viewing platform.
